How will the national competition be held at our school?

- After the art teacher has accepted and read the invitation. The students must be given explanations of the details.
- Each student should be provided with a photocopy of the pertinent competition after receiving payment.
- 15% of the total sum is to be used by the school to make photocopies of the papers and send them to us by mail or courier.
- The remaining 85% of the money must be transferred to us either directly by NEFT to the organization's account or by a D.D. (Demand Draft).
- If payment is done via Demand Draft, ensure the Demand Draft is enclosed in the package that also contains the competition materials and entry form.
- Please include a copy of the bank receipt with the package if the money has been transferred to a bank account.
- Please give us the full breakdown of remittances.



Schedule of national and international competitions

The Rangotsav Celebration is attempting to bring this competition to schools in several nations. Our competitions are planned to be held in 156 nations, including India. For further information, go to the international website.

Competition Schedule

June : Competition at the national level will start on June 15 of 2023.

September: The competition ends on September 20, 2023.

October : Results will be announced in the second week of October.

December: Competition at the international level starts on December

15th, 2023.

January : Ongoing months of competition at the international level

February: The international contest ends on February 15, 2024.

March : Results will be announced in the second week of March.
